### **GOD'S MISSION — TO THOSE IN PRISON**

On Wednesday, October 22, 2014, four young men at the Antanimora Youth Prison were baptized and confirmed. They were the first class at this prison. At the worship service, Pastor Mamy preached on the Gospel lesson from John 9:1-11 about the man who was blind from birth, but through Jesus' love and compassion for him he received his sight. The service concluded with the newly baptized and confirmed and the rest of the congregation at the prison receiving Holy Communion.

Friends of Madagascar Mission is pleased to be a partner with the Malagasy Lutheran Church in supporting this ministry to seven prisons. We also are a major provider of funds for this ministry, supporting over 90% of the program's cost. We need \$18,628.00 in 2014 to meet our budget promise to the Prison Ministry. The prison ministry supported by FOMM is a vital ministry in Madagascar. The ministry serves men, women and youth prisons. There is also a ministry to a prison where more violent offenders are kept. For 50 years Ejeda Hospital has provided an important service for the medical needs of southwest Madagascar.
